

NOTICE OF MEETING

SIENNA PLANTATION LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS

The Board of Directors of Sienna Plantation Levee Improvement District of Fort Bend County, Texas, will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, March 6, 2019, at 11:30 a.m., at the offices of The Muller Law Group, PLLC, 202 Century Square Boulevard, Sugar Land, TX 77478, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approval of minutes.
2. Comments from the public.*
3. Approval of Annual Report and authorizing filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. payment of the bills and review of investments.
5. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and quarterly TIRZ payments.
6. Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation.
7. Operation and maintenance of District facilities, billings, and repairs, including:
 - a. Residential Access Permit applications (LMS).
8. Reports on maintenance, mowing, fertilization and herbiciding of District facilities and maintenance of District waterways (CDC Unlimited, LMS, and Berg Oliver).
9. LJA Engineering matters, including:
 - a. review of 2018 capital improvements projected schedule and potential modifications;
 - b. authorization to design facilities and approval of proposals for design of construction projects;
 - c. approval of plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction projects, including:
 - i. internal back-up sluice gates to serve the South Pump Station;
 - ii. internal back-up sluice gates to serve the North Pump Station;
 - iii. Gulf Coast Water Authority sluice gates at the Sienna Parkway structure;
 - iv. Gulf Coast Water Authority pump house sluice gates;
 - v. Flap gates at Oyster Creek south outfall;
 - vi. External flap gates to serve the South Pump Station;
 - vii. Sienna South Pump Station, phase 2; and
 - viii. Channel 4 widening, phase 4.
 - d. review of bids and award contracts for construction projects in the District, including:
 - i. South Pump Station No. 4, Phase 1(Toll-GTIS).
 - e. pay estimates and change orders, acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facility and obtain necessary maintenance bonds; including:
 - i. North Pump Station sluice gates, sluice gates at Acreage Estates, and back-up sluice gates at outfall structure no. 2 (special projects fund);
 - ii. Channel 3 Improvements, Phase 2 Expansion (Channel 3-3 to Main Channel) (Series 2017 Bonds); and
 - iii. Main Channel expansion and regional storage, phase 1 (Series 2018 Bonds); and
 - f. Steep Bank Creek erosion repair project, including:

- i. approval of design and purchase of materials; and
 - ii. agreement with Fort Bend County Drainage District.
- g. Master Drainage Plan Update;
- h. deeds, easements, maintenance agreements and consents to encroachment;
- i. permit application(s), including permit violations and assessing fines per District policy;
- j. Capital Improvement Plan; and
- k. \$30,000,000 bond application.
- 10. Report regarding development in the District.
- 11. District applications to Federal Emergency Management Agency, including:
 - a. 2016 and 2017 reimbursement applications; and
 - b. Mitigation application.
- 12. Fort Bend Flood Management Association matters.
- 13. Stormwater Quality Management Plan, including:
 - a. Comments from the public and any necessary training;
 - b. Master Services Agreement with Storm Water Solutions.
- 14. Future meeting dates and agenda items.
- 15. Convene in executive session in accordance with Texas Government Code, Section 551.072 to deliberate about real property.
- 16. Reconvene in open session.
